ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

- Children of Police Shuhada and Constabulary, studying abroad in foreign institutions will be awarded IGP Scholarship, one-time in educational career and maximum upto two years, depending upon the duration of the degree.
- These scholarships will be offered upto 5 scholars, as per the allocated amount for that particular year, in accordance with the policy of the department.
- Applications will be scrutinized, and upto 5 scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Eligibility criteria for student/scholar applicants: -

- Enrollment in a foreign university accredited/ ranked by Q's or Time's ranking.
- Pursuing a full-time graduate or postgraduate program.
- Engaged in on-campus academic activities (not enrolled in distance learning).
- Students already availing any scholarship / funding will not be eligible.
- Pursuing a degree in the fields specified hereafter.
- Students / Scholars securing admission during the calendar year 2023.
- Scholarship recommendations determined by the scrutiny committee/department will not be challengeable / contestable.

SPECIFIC FIELDS OF STUDY

- Medical & Dentistry field
- Engineering
- IT/Computer Science
- Economics, Business, Finance & Accountancy
- Important Social Sciences like Environment, Public Administration, law etc.

SALIENT FEATURES

- Scholarships will be awarded @ the maximum scholarship amount given to a student in Pakistan during one academic/calendar year.
- One-way ticket will also be given to the candidates winning the scholarship.
- Laptops/study aids will also be provided.
