1. INTRODUCTION.

Article “32” of Police Order 2002 makes annual policing plan mandatory for every head of the district police, in which he put forward details of objectives and achievement and set targets to be achieved for good performance of the police.

I.DETAIL OF DISTRICT IN A BIRD’S EYE VIEW

Gujranwala is one of the most populous and famous Cities of the country. It has a novel, unique and significant geography. Because, it is situated at distance of 42 Miles in the North of Lahore on Grand Trunk Road The main Railway Track from Peshawar to Karachi passes through it. Due to these communication means, its industrial, commercial and agricultural activities have been multiplied which generate huge revenue.

District Wazirabad and famous river Chenab are situated at its North. The Manchester of Pakistan is situated in its South West whereas area of Sheikhpura lies in its South. The City of Iqbal is shining in its East.

It will not be out of place to mention here that it was established by one Khan Sansi about three hundred years before. He named this piece of land as “Khan Pur Sansi”. One thing which is common in the old and new Gujranwala, is its prosperity. The prominent English historian Mr. W.W. Hunter has also confirmed this fact in his book. The present Gujranwala is famous for the followings:-

➤ **INDUSTRY.**

Doubtlessly Gujranwala has emerged as a main Center of Industry in the Region. High quality electronic motors, fans etc are manufactured here. Similarly, fine textile items are also produced here. The crockery, sanitary items, plastic furnishers, steel products, vehicles parts and bodies of automobiles are the major industry of this City. Due to its significance and importance, its status was raised to District in 1892. It consists of 24 Police Stations and 03 Tehsils namely Gujranwala, Noshera Virkan and Kamoke.

➤ **CROPS.**

Allah almighty has blessed this District with rich fertile land, therefore, all kinds of crops including orchards of different fruits can also be seen in different parts of the District. However, the rice, wheat, sugarcane, maize are the major cash crops of the District. The rice of this District is famous all over the world for its unique taste and flavour. Due to the heavy production of rice, rice markets were established since long long ago at Kamoke and Qila Didar Singh. Rice Mills have been installed in different parts of the District. Rice is exported to a large number of countries of the world. However, the export business has also flourished in the District in recent time.

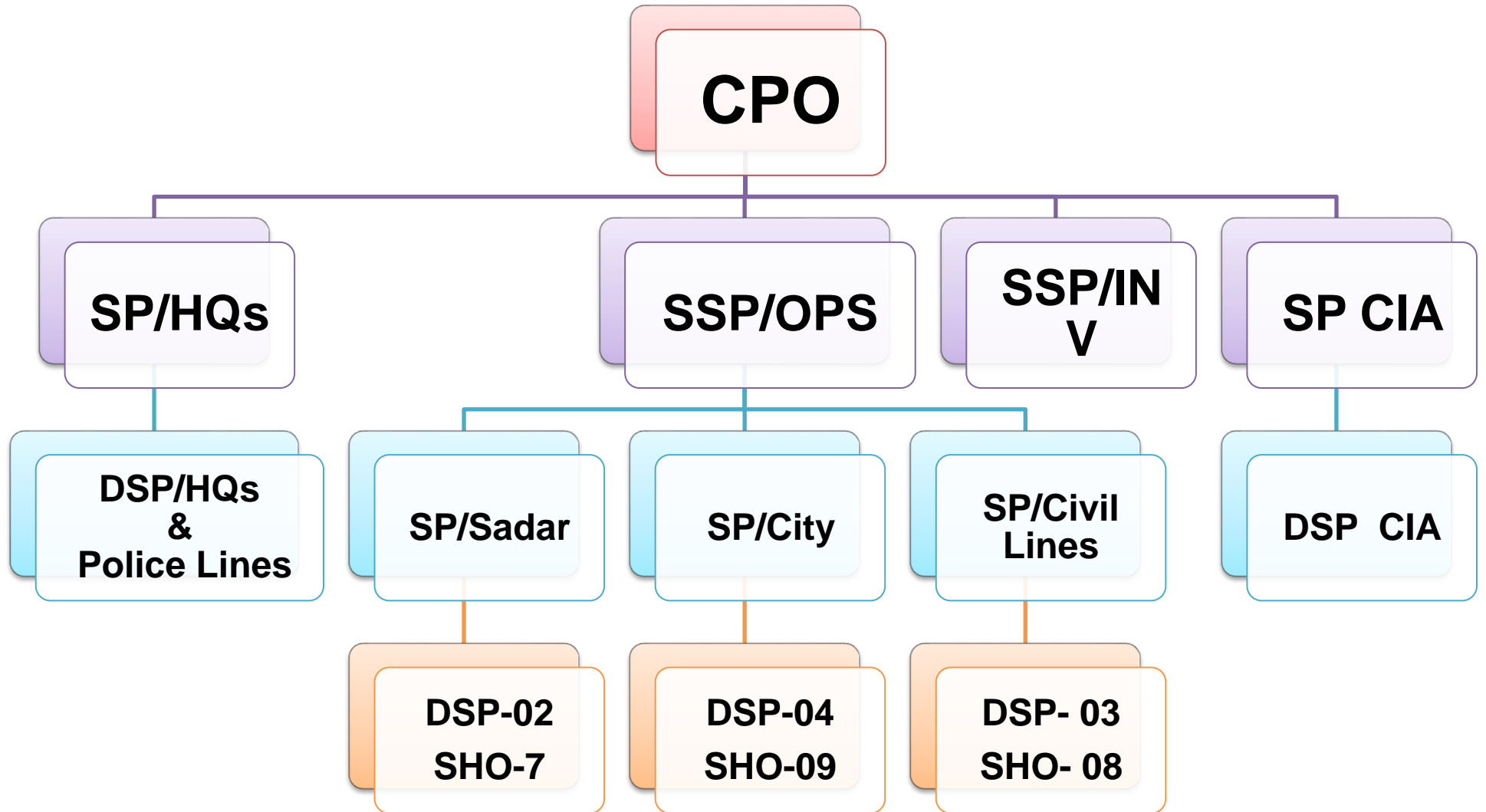
➤ **WRESTLER/WRESTLING**

2. OBJECTIVES OF DISTRICT POLICE:

i. Protect the life, property and liberty of the citizens:-

In order to protect the life, property and liberty of the citizens:-

The District Police has taken the following steps:-

- Regular 24 hours patrolling
- Supervision of patrolling by the senior officer (DMO) .
- 15 Helpline activation.
- Establishment of Dolphin Force
- Establishment of Haider Force to enhance patrolling exercise.
- Naqa Bandies/Special Naqa Bandies
- SOS Naqa Bandies by the order of senior officers
- Search and combing operations
- Foot patrolling in the congested areas
- Mounted patrolling in narrow streets of the City Areas.

ii. Preserve and promote public peace.

In order to preserve and promote the public peace, the following steps have been taken by the District Police:-

- Establishment of Peace Committees
- Establishment of Citizen Police Liaison Committee (CPLC)

- Musehlty Committees
- Thekri Pehras where practicable/feasible
- Establishment of Khidmat Markaz/Mobile Khidmat Markaz (for the issuance of driving license/ permit, provision of Character certificate and copies of FIRs.

iii. In order to improve the police efficiency, the following steps are taken:-

- Regular courses for improvement in investigation skills are carried out at District Police Lines, Gujranwala.
- Selection of well qualified Duty Officers/Muharrars at Police Stations.
- Effective supervision of front desk offices.
- Formal and informal inspection of police stations is conducted by gazetted officers.
- Surprise visits of police station and others security zones by Senior Officers/Gazetted Officers.
- Special directions to SsP, DSsP for the checking of torture/violence, illegal confinement has been passed.
- Special training to anti riot units.
- Formation of Special homicide investigation Unit for investigation of murder cases.
- Disbursement of investigation funds.

Achievements

- It is stated that 304 gangs involved in dacoity and robbery were arrested and stolen property recovered is worth Rs.136336900.
- 7 Top ten and Top Twenty proclaimed offenders from the list of Inspector General of Police were arrested.
- Fool proof security arrangements were made for Smooth and peaceful Muharram-ul-Harram.
- Different types of accessories/supporting/medicinal equipment were distributed in Special children including wheelchair, tab, laptop, Remote control car, Chairs, bicycle, hearing devices and financial assistance was also given for besides medical assistance.
- Three cases kidnapping for ransom has been finalized and abductee were recovered and accused were arrested.
- A large amount of Rs.98100000/- has been recovered in two separate incidents of cash vans in which separate cases were got registered of police station Tattlay Aali and City Wazirabad. Accused were arrested and cases have been finalized.
